## Toll4Europe Signs Contract as First EETS Provider with the Toll Charger of the Netherlands (RDW)

Munich, 17 March 2025 – Toll4Europe has become the first European Electronic Toll Service (EETS) provider to sign a contract with the Dutch toll charger RDW. This marks a significant milestone in the implementation of the new Dutch truck toll system, set to launch in mid-2026, and a clear commitment from Toll4Europe to offer the toll service for Dutch and European customers from the start of the service.

From mid of 2026 onwards, the Netherlands will introduce a distance-based toll system for trucks over 3.5 tons. Similarly to neighboring countries, the toll will apply to all highways and selected provincial and municipal roads. The toll rate will also depend on the truck's emission class, with lower-emission vehicles benefiting from reduced charges.

"The EETS-compliant introduction of the Dutch HGV tolling system will further enhance harmonization within the European tolling landscape. We are eager to provide this important service extension to Dutch and European customers, ensuring seamless, cross-border toll collection and settlement through operational excellence.", says Felix Wex, CEO of Toll4Europe.

To comply with the new toll regulations, all trucks operating in the Netherlands must be equipped with On-Board Units (OBUs) that record the kilometers driven on toll roads. Preparations for the system's implementation are currently underway, ensuring the necessary technical infrastructure is in place for a seamless launch.

We are delighted to take this major step together with the Dutch government, reinforcing our commitment to sustainable and efficient mobility solutions in Europe.
